 - 2) * Values with this purple background are 24-hour amounts (shown by multiple dates) that supersede the maximum calendar-day amount, where known.
 - 3) **Orange background locations are wholly or partially FAA or Military stations (non-NWS First-Order or COOP), except where indicated as an ASOS station (NWS).**
 - 4) With some locations Multi-stations were used for one City to keep a continuous record, (e.g., Airports, Downtowns, Police Barracks (MSP), Utility Companies, Universities, Govts.)
 - 5) Some cities or stations have changed names through the years. The most recent observing city name is portrayed or the closest town name is used. Some of these changes are:
Mt. St. Mary's is Emmitsburg; Yarrow is Rockville; Maryland Agricultural College is College Park; Bell is Glenn Dale; State Sanatorium is Sabillasville; Pleasant Hill is Owings Mills.
 - 6) There is inclusion of some short-term Cities for "Complete" coverage (some Counties/geographic areas are void of stations).
 - 7) Due to numerous inconsistencies in precipitation measurements for many Automated Weather Observing Systems (AWOS) and Remote Automated Weather Stations (RAWS) from available sources, these stations are not shown in this listing. However, one of the RAWS locations, Assateague Island, reported the following during an extremely wet period in September 2016: Maximum Daily Rainfall of 11.17" (9/29) and a monthly total of 16.41". These values match well with surrounding stations on the Southern Eastern Shore so are provided here.
 - 8) * In 1896, data for the month of December was not reported for either of the Washington, DC stations of Receiving Reservoir (Dalecarlia) nor the Distributing Reservoir (Georgetown). Surrounding stations received no more than 0.30" for that entire month. Excluding 1896, the next lowest Annual amounts are: Receiving Reservoir 31.79" (1894) and Distributing Reservoir 27.13" (1894). Therefore, even if the December 1896 monthly totals were known, that year would still likely be the driest.
 - 9) * St. Inigoes Airport (Webster Field) AWOS reported a 2024 Annual Total of 25.16" of precipitation but had a total of 18 days of missing data. Research showed that the nearby Patuxent River (NAS) AWOS reported measurable precipitation on only 2 of those 18 days, 0.07" on August 19th and 0.10" on December 29th, totaling 0.17". This would still be far below the next lowest Annual Total for St. Inigoes, which was 32.95" in 2007.
 - 10) Blue background location is a Remote Automated Weather Station (RAWS) on the Atlantic Coast at Assateague Island. This data, which is collected and stored by the National Interagency Fire Center, Boise, ID, has instruments and siting that might not be congruent with National Weather Service standards. Most RAWS precipitation data is not very reliable but the Assateague Island data is being included in the table due to the extreme amounts for a calendar day and month for that area, which compare favorably with other stations in southern Maryland and the Eastern Shore during this event.
